### About The Director

Since our last write-up on JERRY SILVERS, he has added yet another laurel to his growing list of awards. That was the K.P. Best Director award for the 1961 production THE RAINMAKER. Jerry has also won this coveted award for STREET CAR NAMED DESIRE and HUSBAND FOR BREAKFAST. Other plays he has directed include LULLABY, DETECTIVE STORY, DARK OF THE MOON, and FIFTH SEASON. Jerry has also acted in TIME OF YOUR LIFE, MOUSETRAP, FRONT PAGE and MIDDLE OF THE NIGHT (for which he won the Best Minor Role Award).

## About The Cast

DAVE MIZRAHI (Rubin) was last seen on our stage in ALL THE KINGS MEN. Our audiences will remember Dave particularly in the part of Johnny in LULLA-BY, his first lead role for Kentwood Players. Other K.P. appearances were in BIG KNIFE, DETECTIVE STORY and THE RAINMAKER.

CORRINE WILLIAMS (Cora) makes her first appearance with Kentwood Players. Corrine studied drama at Los Angeles City College and El Camino College and has made many stage appearances at College and Southern California little theaters. She returns to theater work after five years as a stewardess with United Airlines.

MICHAEL MIZRAHI (Sonny) makes his acting debut in this play. Son of Dave Mizrahi, eleven year old Michael attends Loyola Village Elementary School. He is gaining local fame as a brilliant Little League baseball pitcher.

ELYSE SILVERS (Reenie) is very active in drama in Junior High School. In addition to her drama studies, she has acted in and directed many school plays. This is her first K.P. role. Elyse is the daughter of director Jerry Silvers.

ALOYCE RAY (Flirt) is another product of Junior High drama classes. She has appeared in several school plays and also has been taking dancing lessons for eight years. This is her first little theater role.

JACK RIGNEY (Morris) last appeared in PAPA IS ALL for Kentwood Players. Jack has extensive little theater experience, particularly in the San Francisco area. Some of the plays he has appeared in for other groups include LULLABY, BELLS ARE RINGING, KIND SIR and MR. ROBERTS.

EDYTHE SILLS (Lottie) will be remembered as the mother in our production of LULLABY, which was her first California stage appearance.
