

JODY M. FIELDS (Theodora, 1st Card Girl) — At age 2½ Jody had started her career, first with AROUND THE WORLD IN 80 DAYS, then progressed with MARY POPPINS, CABARET, THE BOYFRIEND, etc. Welcome to K.P.

LYDIA LEE (Belly Dancer Exotique) — Was last seen in our production of CABARET. Started her theatre interest at Narbonne H.S. She has appeared at L.A. Harbor College in GRAB THE RING and others. Also will be taking the part of the Gypsy, Princess Ava.

SALLY PIERCE (Tara, Queen of the Gypsies) — Sally is a member of K.P. for over 21 years, and has been in more than a dozen of our productions, winning K.P. awards for a half dozen or so. Was last seen in CABARET, and before that in 40 CARATS, INHERIT THE WIND, FIDDLER, SHRIKE, TIME OF THE CUCKOO, etc.

TERU McPHIE (Gypsy Princess Magda) — Has had ten years of ballet training and is our choreographer. Has a score of credits to her repertoire: GUYS AND DOLLS, DAMN YANKEES, AESOP'S FABLES, etc.
