DORIS MAZEROV (Director) — A four-time Vice President of Kentwood, a member of K.P. for over 30 years, a mistress of all-trades, Director, Producer, and Actress. She has won many awards as best Director for MAN OF LA MANCHA, & CAT ON A HOT TIN ROOF, also Producing laurels for VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE & TAMING OF THE SHREW. Masque Awards for her talents as an actress include STREETCAR NAMED DESIRE, SUMMER AND SMOKE, ALL THE KING'S MEN, BUTTERFLIES ARE FREE, VERONICA'S ROOM. This past season she appeared on our stage in the part of Dr. Petrelli in TRIBUTE.

ABOUT THE PRODUCER

ALAN STEVENS (Producer) — A five year member of Kentwood, Alan's contributions have been numerous. He has worked on more than eight productions, however this is his first venture as Producer. Alan started as Sound Engineer in the booth for SUMMERTREE, STEAMBATH & COME BACK LITTLE SHEBA. His talents do not end here, he has been Stage Manager for the following shows: GOD'S FAVORITE, CALIFORNIA SUITE, CHAPTER TWO, GODSPELL, and THREE MEN ON A HORSE. In addition, Alan also serves the theatre in the capacity of Mailing Chairman.

ABOUT THE CAST

DICK BEGA (Officer Harry Haggerty) is approaching 21 years of active membership with Kentwood Players. He served on the Board of Directors as Mailing Chairman. His latest endeavor was as Producer for our recent production of DEATHTRAP, AND SAME TIME NEXT YEAR. His first appearance on our stage was A VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE, which he later recreated this role in the K.P. Award Winner for the L.A. County Drama Festival. Other credits include roles in THE ROSE TATOO, THE ODD COUPLE, STEAMBATH, for which he won the Masque Award for Best Actor, in a Cameo Role, and SILVER WHISTLE, for which he won a Masque Award for Best Minor Support.

GARRETT NICHOLS (Aaron Levinsky) — This marks the second time that we have had the honor of seeing Garrett on our stage. He first appeared as Leo in our production of ROMANTIC COMEDY last season. He received his training at the Uta Hagen-Herbert Berghof Studios in N.Y. Garrett has appeared in such productions as The Candidate, Street Scene, and The Lesson, and the Boston's Loeb Theatre in Waiting for Godot. His L.A. appearances are El Camino Real, Time Step, The Party, and last year he appeared in The Shadow Box at the Westside Repertory Theatre.

BOB PRICE (Franklin Macmillan) has been an ardent Thespian for over 30 years and a long record of stage appearances, Bob was first seen on our stage in our musical FOLLIES. A three time Best Actor award winner, he has appeared in numerous Morgan Theatre presentations, Mind with a Dirty Man, Our Town, Girl Crazy, and Of Mice & Men. Other appearances at K.P. are, THREE MEN ON A HORSE, GYPSY, & COME BACK LITTLE SHEBA. Received his training in San Francisco, London and Los Angeles.

CARY BAKER (The Recorder) — A two year member of Kentwood. Cary's credits include Stage Manager for ROMANTIC COMEDY, and TRIBUTE. She has worked in our Sound Booth for our production of THE RUNNER STUMBLES and as Script Supervisor for CHAPTER TWO. This marks Cary's first appearance on stage since her High School Thespian days.

ALICE ELDRIDGE (Rose Kirk) — Fifteen years ago, Alice was a newcomer to Kentwood but not new as an actress. Familiar to South Bay audiences, she has appeared in California Suite, Last of the Red Hot Lovers, The Odd Couple and many more. Her first appearance on our stage was in GUYS AND DOLLS, in the role of Adelaide, winning Best Actress Award for her talents. Then went on to appear in THE GINGERBREAD LADY, again taking the Best Supporting Actress Award. Other credits are HOW THE OTHER HALF LOVES, ANGEL STREET, DON'T DRINK THE WATER. A talented writer she has written the book and lyrics for the Musical Comedy, Ollie's Oasis.

BILL BUHLER (Arthur Kirk) started acting as a KP member 30 years ago when he played "Whirling Joe Ferguson" in THE MALE ANIMAL. Some of his later credits include A STREETCAR NAMED DESIRE, A CASE OF LIBEL, MAN OF LA MANCHA, INHERIT THE WIND, OUR TOWN, etc. He is also the author of the KP production THE DARK SOUL OF THE GENTLE SEX. He served as Chairman of the Plays Commmittee and is also Past President of Kentwood Players.

HARVEY ROSENBERG (Dr. Herbert Rosenthal) made his stage debut at Kentwood in our production of THE ODD COUPLE in 1968. Since then he has appeared in numerous productions such as: FIDDLER ON THE ROOF, GUYS AND DOLLS, PRISONER OF SECOND AVENUE, LAST OF THE RED HOT LOVERS, SILVER WHISTLE, HOT L BALTIMORE, MY THREE ANGELS to name a few.

PAUL MAZEROV (Judge Murdoch) — Does this name sound familiar??? It should. An accomplished actor, Paul not only has decorated our stage with his acting in COME BACK LITTLE SHEBA, ANDERSONVILLE TRIAL, CATCH ME IF YOU CAN, and FOLLIES he is also an artist and producer, having produced CAT ON A HOT TIN ROOF and VERONICA'S ROOM (which won him our Masque Awards as Best Producer). His other Producing credits are OKLAHOMA, CALIFORNIA SUITE, and COMPANY. Last year he also produced TRIBUTE. His Set Design achievements are for CALIFORNIA SUITE and TRIBUTE.

SUSAN MICHAEL (Claudia Faith Draper) attended El Camino College and California State University, Northridge, where she had leading roles in The Madwoman of Chaillot, Cinderella, The Diary of Anne Frank and Arms and the Man. At Santa Paula High School she directed Blithe Spirit and the Musical, Wizard of Oz. Susan charmed K.P. audiences with her debut performance in 1970 in READY WHEN YOU ARE C.B., and in August of the same year in GUYS & DOLLS. Most recently she appeared in Dark Deeds at Swan's Place at Theatre Americana and Rainbows at the Deja Vu Coffeehouse. If you say 'Work Sunday' to Susan and her husband Tommy, it is like a magnet, they show up and give their all for K.P.
