ABOUT THE DIRECTOR

SHELDON METZ - After the Dancing in Jericho marks Sheldon's 59th production as a director and over 35 years since his first directing chore. You Can't Kiss Caroline. Sheldon has been a member of K.P. for over 14 years. As an actor, he appeared in I Never Sang for My Father. The Supporting Cast, and numerous workshops. He has directed Lunch Hour, The Octette Bridge Club, Annie Get Your Gun, Play It Again, Saml, The Cocktail Hour (Best Director and Set Design), The Good-By People (Best Set Design), the highly acclaimed A Few Good Men, and last year's Beau Jest. This past year, in his spare time, he designed sets for Beau Jest. Mr. Roberts, and Gin Game. Professionally, he directed Love Letters in 1995 with Bonnie Franklin and Tony Musante, and Richard Kline and Karen Valentine.
