COLE ALBERT PORTER WAS BORN ON JUNE 9, 1893, IN PERU, INDIANA. HIS FATHER WAS SAMUEL FENWICK PORTER AND MOTHER WAS KATE COLE. HE RECEIVED HIS FORMAL EDUCATION AT WORCESTER ACADEMY (1905-09), YALE COLLEGE (1909-13), HARVARD LAW AND MUSIC SCHOOLS (1913-16) AND THE SCHOLA CANTORIUM IN PARIS (1920-21). HE MARRIED LINDA LEE THOMAS IN 1919. IRVING BERLIN, A GREAT ADMIRER, WAS COLE'S CLOSEST FRIEND. COLE'S FAMILY WEALTH, COUPLED WITH THAT OF HIS WIFES, GAVE HIM TIME TO WORK HARD AT DEVELOPING HIS WORDS AND MUSIC SKILLS. HE WROTE SPECIAL SONGS FOR MONTY WOOLEY, FANNY BRICE AND PRODUCERS OF HIS DAY. COLE PORTER DIED ON OCTOBER 15, 1964, LEAVING HUNDREDS OF SONGS FOR PEOPLE TO ENJOY.
