## Director's Note



The first time I saw Fun Home I completely fell in love with the beautiful and brutal honesty expressed in the music and story. I felt the messages of love, courage, self-discovery and hopefulness were very important to share. I also felt the pain, desolation and darkness.

We feel each character's struggle, and are given the opportunity to understand the varied events that form each of them. While some people see this play as being very sad, I view it more as experiencing sad events, yet always moving forward with acceptance and forgiveness to the future. In many ways, we are reminded that we each have our own story, our own struggle, and yet continue on with our own memories and the belief that

there is an element of joy in our lives.

Throughout the rehearsal process, we found that many of us had difficult stories that we shared, brought up because of the emotions and experiences being portrayed.

While the struggles in the show are difficult issues, it is important to know that asking for help is never a sign of weakness, but of strength.


