MONTY ASH (Director) — Having been a member since 1965 — Monty has been a Jack-of-all-Trades to Kentwood. He has shown his talents as producer, director, actor and portrait photographer. He has served as stage manager, lighting designer and technician — as well as serve on the Board of Directors as Publicity Chairman. Some of his more recent directorial credits include: COME BACK LITTLE SHEBA, A VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE, INHERIT THE WIND, A CASE OF LIBEL and TORCH-BEARERS. Some of his acting credits include: HOT L BALTIMORE, DRACULA and FIDDLER ON THE ROOF.

PAUL MAZEROV (Produer & Set Designer) — With his membership going on 9 years — Paul is certainly not new to producing here at Kentwood. Some of his producing credits include: CAT ON A HOT TIN ROOF (which won him our Masque Award as Best Producer), VERONICA'S ROOM (which won him yet another Masque Award for his fine production work), OKLAHOMA, CALIFORNIA SUITE, and COMPANY. IRV ROSEN (Lou Daniels) — Being an active member of Kentwood for the past 25 years, Irv has done just about everything (theatrically speaking that is)! He has appeared in countless productions including: SEND ME NO FLOWERS, DETECTIVE STORY, JANUS, AND MY THREE ANGELS. His performance as Snogg in RED SHOES won him the 1961 K.P. Best Actor Award and in 1967 he was honored with the Best Actor Award presented by the L.A. County Adult Drama Festival for his performance in the Kentwood production of A VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE. He has served as our Past President and is currently on the Board of Directors.

DODI MAZEROV (Dr. Gladys Petrelli) — Having been a long standing member of Kentwood for over 30 years she lists many productions to her credit. Some of which include: VERONICA'S ROOM (for which she won our Masque Award for Best Actress), BUTTERFLIES ARE FREE (winning our Masque Award for Best Supporting Actress), CAT ON A HOT TIN ROOF (winning her still another Masque Award — this time around for Best Director), MAN OF LA MANCHA (winning her another Director's Award), FANTASTICS, RASHOMON, and WHO'S AFRAID OF VIRGINIA WOLF (in which she won yet another Masque Award for her fine performance as Best Actress).

DUKE SCHNEIDER (Scottie Templeton) — Having joined Kentwood 5 years ago in the production "GOD'S FAVORITE" (which by the way won him our Masque Award for Best Actor) he brought with him over 25 years of acting experience in the South Bay area. Among some of his credits in leading roles are Steambath, The Good Doctor, 6 Rms Riv Vu, Rattle of a Simple Man, Four On A Garden and Krapps Last Tape. His directing credits include, The Price and he has also had numerous roles in musical comedy offerings.

She is a teacher with the Children's Theatre Arts and is a professional clown with the California Clowns of San Diego.
