ABOUT THE DIRECTOR - Dave Mizrahi

One of Kentwood's finest actors, Dave's work has won him many awards over the years highlighted by powerful performances in THE BIG KNIFE, A VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE, THE PRICE, ALL MY SONS and MY THREE ANGELS. Other memorable Los Angeles appearances have been as Tevye in Fiddler on the Roof, and the title role in Zorba. Dave's award winning Kentwood directorial credits include TWELVE ANGRY MEN and THE SILVER WHISTLE. He was last seen on the Kentwood Stage as Gus Frazier in TWICE AROUND THE PARK.

ABOUT THE PRODUCER - Ina Wentzel

A member only since October 1988, Ina has worked backstage or on technical crew on four productions during 1989: WAIT UNTIL DARK, CRIMES OF THE HEART, THE REAL INSPECTOR HOUND and PACK OF LIES. A first time producer, she says "This is the most fun I've had in years".

ABOUT THE ASSISTANT PRODUCER - Charlotte Lee Gunter

Charlotte's life with the Kentwood Players began in 1958 when we were located at the Pump House. She progressed backstage working in many capacities on 26 productions including PAPA IS ALL, THE ROSE TATTOO, and FORTY CARATS all as producer and THE SUBJECT WAS ROSES which she co-produced. On stage she appeared in STREET CAR NAMED DESIRE, MIDDLE OF THE NIGHT, THE DESPERATE HOURS (for which she received an award), THE TENDER TRAP, SUMMER AND SMOKE, AUNTIE MAME, VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE and LOOK HOMEWARD, ANGEL. In 1960 she was elected to the Board and has been on it ever since, serving numerous positions and is currently Secretary which she's held for 15 years. Most recently, she was script supervisor for PIPPIN. To quote Charlotte, "Kentwood I love you - and you audiences I love you too."

PAMLA ABRAMSON - Barbara Kahn

Pamla was most recently on our stage as "Barbara" in PACK OF LIES. A 17 year KP member she has had major roles in SHE LOVES ME, SWEET CHARITY, STOP THE WORLD I WANT TO GET OFF, COMPANY, LOVERS AND OTHER STRANGERS, A TALENT FOR MURDER and ON A CLEAR DAY YOU CAN SEE FOREVER, for which she received a Marcom Masque Award for Best Actress in a Leading Role. GAIL BERNARDI - Trudy Heyman

Gail is a native of Pennsylvania where she studied acting at Carnegie Mellon's Drama Department. Productions in which she has appeared include both comedy and drama in roles as varied as Emma Kalovortz in "Enter Laughing" to Lady Macbeth in "Macbeth".
