My motivation for choosing to direct *The Producers* was simple. Laughter and lots of it! With the noise of the world often drowning out the desire to stay positive by even the most sanguine of us, the need to laugh is greater than ever. And how can you help but laugh when exposed to the humor of Mel Brooks?

The Producers was written by Mel Brooks and Thomas Meehan based upon Mel's real-life experience, working as an assistant for a producer who financed his plays by sleeping with elderly women. Marry that to his concept of a musical about Nazis and what could go wrong? Mel said, "You get up on a soapbox and you argue with a Nazi, you're going to lose. But if you can ridicule him and make people laugh, then you win. It's as simple as that."

The original film starring Zero Mostel and Gene Wilder, served as the springboard for *The Producers*, the musical. Nathan Lane and Matthew Broderick played Bialystock and Bloom and that production won 12 Tony Awards breaking the record held by Hello Dolly!

If you're looking for a show that's politically correct, then you are in the wrong theatre. The Producers is irreverent and certainly not politically correct, but it is definitely hilarious. Afterall, it is 1959.

We hope that you will enjoy this production and feel free to laugh out loud. We all deserve a good laugh!
